



2021 TD Saturday Market Booth with a Cause Rules & Regulations

The TD Saturday Market, located on Main Street at McBee Avenue, brings together the finest in-season produce, fresh-cut flowers, gourmet foods, and local handmade crafts every Saturday morning from May through October. Each week the market continues to generate excitement and gain support within the community.

Please note, due to the fluidity of the Covid-19 pandemic, modifications to the information below are possible. We remain committed to evaluate and comply with local, state and federal agencies, while continuously keeping the safety of vendors, staff and the community at the forefront of all decisions.

The “Booth with a Cause” at the TD Saturday Market allows local organizations, which focus on farm, farmer, agriculture, youth, health or environmental concerns to increase community awareness and gain exposure. The “Booth with a Cause” provides the opportunity for the market and the community to give back. Interested organizations will be designated one Saturday during the 2021 market season for a fee of \$15, which includes a 10’x10’ tent space and one 6’ table. The “Booth with a Cause” organization may recruit volunteers and hand out literature related to their efforts. Please submit your application as soon as possible. Once dates are scheduled, each organization will also be listed on our website. *This opportunity will be extended only once per group during each market season.*

“Booth with a Cause” organizations are NOT PERMITTED TO SELL ANY ITEMS, but may hand out free items such as literature.

Selection of Organizations

The TD Saturday Market “Booth with a Cause” organizations may not contain material or information that:

1. Is not non-profit in nature
2. Is false, misleading or deceptive
3. Is libelous
4. Promotes unlawful or illegal goods, services or activities
5. Implies or declares an endorsement by the City of Greenville of any goods, services, or activities
6. Contains any obscenity, or sexual conduct or any kind (obscenity is defined as any communication, picture, image, graphic image, or other matter that the average Greenville citizen, applying contemporary standards, would find, taking the material as a whole, appeals to prurient interest and whether it depicts or describes, in a patently offensive way, sexual conduct)
7. Promotes the sale or use of tobacco or tobacco-related products
8. Supports or opposes a political candidate, issue or cause

9. Supports or opposes a religion or religious denomination, creed, tenet or belief, including information or material that supports or opposes atheism or agnosticism.
10. Is determined by the Market Committee to be inconsistent with the goals of the TD Saturday Market and would interfere with the primary purpose of the market.

Event Information

- Dates:** Saturdays, May 1 through October 30 (except October 9)
- Hours of operation:** 7:00 am - Vendors arrive and set-up at event site
7:45 am - All vehicles must be off event site
8:00 am - Market Opens
12:00 noon - Market Closes
12:10 pm - Vendor vehicles may return to event site for loading once given approval by City police or market staff.
- Location:** S. Main Street at McBee Avenue

Rules and Regulations

- **All “Booth with a Cause” participants must be a non-profit, tax-exempt community service agencies.**
- **“Booth with a Cause” organizations are not permitted to sell any items. However donations may be accepted for things such as raffles, event tickets, etc. Donations being accepted for any type of ticket MUST BE APPROVED AT LEAST ONE WEEK PRIOR TO YOUR SCHEDULED WEEK.**
- **Booth must be staffed by organization members for the entire time the Market is open (8:00am – 12:00pm)**
- **Attendance:** Only one community organization is selected to be at the market each week. If you have been selected to participate, please make every effort to keep your commitment. One week (7 days) notice is required if you will not be able to attend a committed Saturday. Failure to be present on a committed date and/or give notice of absence may result in the forfeiture of your privilege to participate in the TD Saturday Market. The market is a rain or shine event and will only be cancelled in the event of severe weather conditions. .
- **Booth Set-up:** The City will setup the tent and table. Vehicles are allowed onsite to unload only. Vendors are encouraged to be creative in decorating their booths/tents. Chairs are not provided.
- **Vendor Parking:** There is plenty of free parking for TD Saturday Market participants near the market site. Pay close attention to the street and parking lot regulations for you may be towed at your risk and expense. All parking must be in a marked parking space outside of the event site. No parking is allowed in any median or lane of traffic (even if the road is closed).
- **Booth Take Down:** No vehicles will be allowed on site until 10 minutes after official market closing time. Please wait for TD Saturday Market staff or police to notify you of when it is safe to enter. “Booth with a Cause” participants must clean up the area around their booth before leaving.

- **Policies for ALL Vendors:**

- The TD Saturday Market standard weekly space includes one 10x10 tent and one 6' table.
- Please come prepared with your own site supplies (extra tables, chairs, tape, tacks, scissors, etc.).
- Per City ordinance, no pets are allowed in the permitted market area – with the exception of service dogs.
- The market reserves the right to refuse participation to vendors who do not comply with market regulations or do not meet Market standards which include, but are not limited to, following all local, city, state, and federal laws and regulations.
- The market is not liable for any injury, theft, or damage to either the buyer or seller, or their property, arising from or pertaining to preparation for or participation in the market.
